






After having presented a draft version of their Integrated Action Plan our network partners are holding final discussions and consultations meetings within their Local Support Groups and with a wider group of stakeholders, in order to finalise the Action Plan and present it by the end of March 2018. The Lead Partner together with the project staff is also engaged in the organisation of the project Final Event that will take place in Brussels on the 23rd and 24th of April 2018, in the premises of the Committee of the Regions. Furthermore two weeks ago took place in Val de Marne the <u>5th Transnational Workshop</u> and 7 th SGM of the project, which have seen the participation of more than 40 persons among delegates, project staff members and local stakeholders along with URBACT representatives.During the workshop a public debate around the theme of the workshop (<u>migrants' and refugees' participation in city life</u>) has been organised, the debate which has seen the intervention of experts, artists and journalists that work in the field of migration in various ways has been a real moment of exchange and participation.

WE INTRODUCE OUR NETWORK PARTNERS



The Municipality of Messina is the capital of the Province of Messina and is the third largest city of Sicily. The port of Messina, the closest point in Sicily to the mainland of Italy, it is an important centre for commerce and for cruise ship tourism. Messina has a long history of migration. The migrant population currently numbers around 12,000, making up about 5% of Messina's population. Messina is a transit point in the current mass movement of refugees from Africa, Asia and the Middle East through Europe and a key transit location for migrants crossing by sea from Libya to Italy.

VAL de MARNE Le département

Val-de-Marne is a County-level authority covering the south east suburbs of Paris and is located within the Ile-de-France region. The county, composed bv 47 municipalities, is historically a land of welcome; its situation within the Ile-de-France makes it a territory of migrations since the Pre-history. More recently, the great wars that have crossed France and industrialisation have accompanied the development of migratory flows on the territory. Looking as the statistics we see that in Val de Marne the people born outside French territory, make up 20% of the population of Val de Marne county.
