




Need to distinguish between various forms:

- Engagement as « giving »










#### WHAT IS « CIVIC PARTICIPATION ?»-2


- Engagement in activities linked to local/national/EU political participation activities
- « Click activism »





















#### WHY IS IT HIGH ON THE AGENDA?

- Disengagement from mainstream political parties










#### WHAT FACTORS ARE CAUSING A DECLINE?

- Identification










### WHAT KEY LESSONS/ISSUES HAVE EMERGED FROM PRACTICE?

- the need to create quality partnership space and time for the relevant stakeholders










### WHAT KEY LESSONS/ISSUES HAVE EMERGED FROM PRACTICE?-2

- there is a need to find new ways of involving the 'hard to reach'










## WHAT KEY LESSONS/ISSUES HAVE EMERGED FROM PRACTICE?-3

- No tool is the best one











 Asset-based community development (ABCD)










