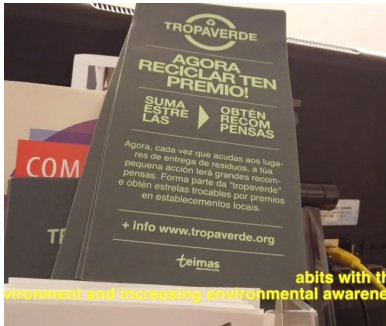


Showing the project evolution

On the 24th and 25th of last month we had two sessions of transnational meetings where the evolution of the project in the 6 participating cities was reported. The imminent launch of the platform in Guimarães and Opole (soon we will talk more on our social networks about the progress in these cities), the response of citizens in cities like Pavlos Melas and Zuglő, or the new evolution that will take place in Santiago was the most notable of all that has been said.

The meetings took place in an enriching and motivating environment where the 6 cities could look in the mirror and see both their results and those of other places (pointing out the legislative and socioeconomic differences that exist in each territory).

The event on the 25th, the Transnational Coffee-Seminar with ULG members, was open to the public and attended by 30 people who were able to resolve any doubts, as well as learn about the difficulties of implementing the project in the participating cities, as well as the successes that some of them are already achieving. Trying to predict the effects of a warming Arctic

According to the [Arctic Report Card](#) the poles are warming twice as fast as anywhere else on Earth. The EU-funded [Blue-Action](#) project was created with the aim to help society better understand and prepare for the effects of a changing Arctic climate. The project evaluates the impact of Arctic warming on the Northern Hemisphere and develops new techniques to improve forecast accuracy on seasonal to decadal timescales.
