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Le FORUM :

L'outil consultatif de l'Eurométropole LKT

- Installé le 28 septembre 2009 par l'Eurométropole LKT sur proposition du Conseil de développement de Lille métropole (2004)
- **60 membres bénévoles représentant la société civile organisée** – associations, entreprises, de différents secteurs, dont
 - 30 français
 - 30 Belges dont 15 Flamands et 15 Wallons
- **Issus des 3 instances consultatives existantes** des territoires de l'Eurométropole :
 - Conseil de développement de Lille métropole (depuis 2002)
 - Conseil de développement de Wallonie picarde (depuis 2006)
 - Transforum –Kortrijk- (depuis 2005)
- Une **expérimentation** de 2 ans sous la présidence de Patrick PEUGEOT et l'animation de son Bureau (3VP + 4 membres)

Le rôle du FORUM :

- Fédère les forces vives du territoire eurométropolitain et **suscite le débat** sur les enjeux de l'Eurométropole
- Répond aux **consultations** à la demande de l'Eurométropole (saisine)
- Participe à l'effort de **prospective** de l'Eurométropole pour nourrir la stratégie politique et opérationnelle de celle-ci
- Constitue une **force de propositions** en faveur de projets s'inscrivant dans la stratégie de l'Eurométropole
- Peut **interpeller les membres de l'Eurométropole** sur tout sujet transfrontalier relatif au territoire de l'Eurométropole (auto-saisine)
- Contribue à **l'évaluation de l'Eurométropole**
- Contribue à ce que l'Eurométropole porte une attention particulière aux forces vives de son territoire, véritables **ambassadeurs chargés de diffuser, relayer, mobiliser les idées**, ...

Le FORUM :
un fonctionnement en lien étroit avec les 3 Conseils
existants pour :

- Favoriser l'intelligence collective au sein du territoire eurométropolitain vécu par les habitants et les acteurs de l'Eurométropole
- Cerner la réelle plus-value – atouts et apports - de l'approche transfrontalière, des thèmes de réflexion mis au débat au profit des eurométropolitains
- Générer la complémentarité des réflexions et éviter les doublons dans les travaux de ces 4 assemblées



Les préoccupations de la société civile sont nombreuses mais des priorités se dégagent autour de :

- L'emploi
- la **mobilité** globale des personnes et du transport des marchandises
- l'**accessibilité** de l'Eurométropole
- L'**appropriation** pleine et entière **du territoire** par tous les acteurs du développement, par tous les habitants
- La **culture** mais aussi le fait de mieux se connaître, se comprendre et se parler (2 langues, 3 régions, cultures différentes)
- La **stratégie de développement** territorial






Background for cross-border governance

(+)

- direct neighbours on both sides of the River Oder
- common university: Viadrina & Collegium Polonicum (since 1991)
- quite strong political focus on the german-polish border
- situated on the important european transport axis Paris-Berlin-Warsaw-Moscow

(-)

- no common language, low neighbour language skills
- low level of own regional or local identification
- economic, historical based and mental differences
- lack of economic development, employment rate and infrastructures
- bad experiences in cross-border participative democracy

Frankfurt(O)-Slubice

Frankfurt-Slubice Future Conference 2020

(4-6 June 2009)

- More than 200 participants from all parts of the society and from both cities
- **Methods:** short inputs, lots of interactive workshops, open results
- **Main results:**
common, broadly shared vision for 2020; examples: joint center
town; common public transport; bi-lingual daily life, beginning in the kindergarten,
“special education area Viadrina”



Frankfurt(O)-Slubice

Long term results of our participative approach

- Representatives of institutions take part in **regular working groups**: city planning, culture, education, economic development, city marketing, “family-friendly twin city”
- From now on at least one open, **interactive conference each year**
- Larger **media interest**
- German-Polish **web forum**: www.frankfurt.slubice.pl
- Sustainability: **Local Action Plan 2010-2020**: 26 goals, 18 projects

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Involvement of social actors in Ister-Granum EGTC

EGTC involves civil organizations through:

- „**Civil Parliament**” as integral part and element of the EGTC's institution structure
 - ✓ Public Association
 - ✓ 20 active members, about 900 recorded NGOs

Role:

- strengthen the relation between Hungarian and Slovakian civil organizations,
- articulate common interests,
- launching common programs, events and projects,
- operate the Service Network for Nonprofit Organizations of Ister-Granum EGTC,
- participate in the work of Expert Board of Ister-Granum EGTC

Involvement of social actors in Ister-Granum EGTC

- „Service Network for Nonprofit Organizations of Ister-Granum EGTC“ as project financed network for NGOs.

Role:

- Support civil organization at local level
- Operate an advisory network
- Facilitate project generation

Involvement of economic actors in Ister-Granum EGTC

The EGTC involves significant economic (employers) actors through:

- **Regional Development Council** representing top 3 regional employers (e.g. Suzuki Hungary) and national (regional) authorities (Regional Employment Agency, Chamber of Commerce and Industry)

Role:

- Support strategic planning
- Coordinate regional development
- Announce own development plans
- Promote common risk management (e.g. reduction economic performance)

The structure for involving socio-economic actors is:

- Democratic,
- Ensures free participation,
- Flexible,
- Bottom-up approach based,
- Operates within the structure of the EGTC.

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OBJECTIVES OF A PARTICIPATIVE DEMOCRACY WITHIN THE EUROCITY

- Contribute to the creation of a common social area
- Promote a common cultural heritage
- Bring popular or citizens' initiatives for the governance of the Eurocity
- Embrace a Eurocity identity

STRATEGY TO INVOLVE LOCAL ACTORS

1. Identification of main actors within civil society and creation of focus groups
2. Participation of socio-economic agents in the organization and implementation of the Eurocity activities:
 - ✓ 2.1 Representatives from the civil society have taken part in the elaboration of the Strategic Agenda through the consultation process.
 - ✓ 2.2 Participation in activities on axis 1 and 2: citizenship and economic dynamization

Participation in axis 1 and 3 of the Eurocity

- **AXIS 1: Citizenship activities:**
 - Eurocitizen card (commerce associations)
 - Citizenship training (representatives from schools)
 - Common cultural Agenda (cultural associations)
- **AXIS 3: Economic dynamization activities:**
 - Economic forum
 - Dynamization of traditional commerce (trade associations)




