CONTEST RULES

The following are the official rules for URBACT Children drawing contest “Draw your ideal city” taking place within the framework of the European Cooperation day (21 September and surrounding week) .

The URBACT Children Drawing Contest is produced by URBACT European Programme for Sustainable Urban development. The Contest begins on or about **15 May 2013** and ends with the announcement of winner on **20 September 2013**. These contest rules are subject to modification by URBACT.

CONTEST THEME

All drawings submitted to the competition must reflect the theme “**My Ideal City**”.

What would look like the city you would wish to live in?

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The contest is open to children residents of all **cities partners in an URBACT project**.

Entrants must be **aged 6 to 12** at the time of entry.

Only one entry per child will be accepted; all subsequent entries will be disqualified.

No purchase is necessary.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

1. Draw your ideal city and be inventive§

- > Paper Format: A4 – good quality white paper
- > Child's name, age and city written at the bottom-right of the drawing

RESULTS

Competition winner will be announced on URBACT website on **20 September 2013**.

Winning drawing will be displayed and promoted on our website and social media tools.
