Objective

The Project Meeting in Graz is the 2nd Thematic Seminar during Phase II of the network HerO - Heritage as Opportunity. Building up on the results of the HerO Kick-Off-Conference in Poitiers, it aims to deepen our knowledge on integrated management systems for historic urban landscapes in order to enable all HerO partners to develop a "Cultural Heritage Integrated Management Plan" for each city. After elaborating a common understanding of a "Cultural Heritage Integrated Management Plan" and discussing its objective, purpose and typical contents, we will this time focus on "Organizational and Operational Structures" as well as the "Elaboration or Adaptation Process" (Workshop 2/3 on Management Plans).

Conjointly we will exchange on the co-operation with our Managing Authorities and the work with our Local Support Groups. Our Lead Expert Nils Scheffler will present a first draft of the HerO Good Practice Compilation. Furthermore, the project meeting in Graz provides a platform to discuss organizational and administrative issues, communication strategies and finances.
