



Issues to be analysed concerning the current situation

- Kind of cultural heritage and state of preservation
- Significance and value of historic area and tangible cultural heritage
- Demands of 'users' towards historic urban area and cultural heritage
- Dangers and threats to historic area and tangible cultural heritage
- Existing instruments of safeguarding heritage values
- Existing sectoral and integrated strategies, plans, actions, etc. directed/ affecting historic areas and tangible cultural heritage
- Existing structures and procedures for safeguarding and further development of cultural heritage and historic urban area







3) Elaboration of the CHIMP: Structure and Procedures

Organisational and operational structures and procedures

- 1. Identify needed structure and procedures in support of
 - objectives of CHIMP
 - implementation and application of MS+integrated approach
- 2. Define the objective for the structure and each procedure
- 3. Develop/ adapt needed structure/ procedures











4) Elaboration of the CHIMP: How to do...

How to do

1. LSG

Regular meetings, workshops, working sessions, doing brainstorming/ asking for provision of information

- 2. Experts
 Interviews, consultations, brainstorming sessions
- 3. Target groups not directly involved in LSG
 Public meetings, hearings, time restricted working
 groups









4) Elaboration of the CHIMP: Pay attention to ...

Pay attention to

- <u>Define</u> field of actions, objectives, topics, goals, actions, structures/procedures <u>based on analysis of current situation</u>.
- <u>Get more concrete</u> from the vision, via the objectives to the goals of topics; they should be <u>measurable</u>.
- Vision, objectives, goals, actions, structures/procedures have to be <u>congruent</u> (no contradictions), <u>deducible</u> and <u>achievable</u>.
- <u>Coordinate</u> objectives, goals, actions, structures/ procedures to identify <u>conflicts/contradictions</u> and <u>make synergies and winwin situations visible</u>.
- Actions/ outputs that do not contribute to the defined goals and objectives should be excluded.
- Assure identification and support of vision, objectives, goals, actions, structures/ procedures by relevant stakeholders
- <u>Make</u> vision, objectives, goals, actions, structures/ procedures <u>well known to the public</u>.









5) Summary

- Do the "chain of deduction" based on analysis of current situation (vision, objectives, goals, actions).
- Develop needed organisational and operational structure/ procedure
- Do it with your LSG and further stakeholders if needed






