


RegioStars 2008 - 26 Finalists - 5 Winners




















REGIONAL POLICY

URBACT II: High interest in the Fast Track Option

- Seven Regions for Economic Change themes included in URBACTII
- 2007: Approv al of two Pilot Fast Track Networks (MILE, URBAMECO)
- 35 out of 92 applications for Thematic networks declared their interest

EUROPEAN COMMISSION

The "Labelling Process"

- In parallel to the quality assessment of the URBACT Managing Authority, the Commission started (parallel) **labelling process**.
- Commission Services: DG Regional Policy + other interested DGs
- Theme-based « Inter-service meetings » and evaluation of all applications based on assessment questions (web)
- Four main sections:
 - Regions for Economic Change & relevance for Cohesion Policy
 - Wider coverage and exchange of experience
 - 2-w ay bridge
 - Transparancy and communications
- Recommendations from Commission Services






