









Brief overview of the of the cultural heritage assets in your town and the area for which a local action plan will be developed (maybe include map and some images)

- Lublin has been the site of the Polish-Lithuanian Union in XVI cent.












Key problems/issues, challenges and potentials concerning the cultural heritage area on which you want to work and exchange experience during the life-time of the project HerO

- Assure the sound urban mixture = secure green space and housing in the city centre and the areas around.



















Your objectives/expectations for the HerO network (on local level and on project level)
