

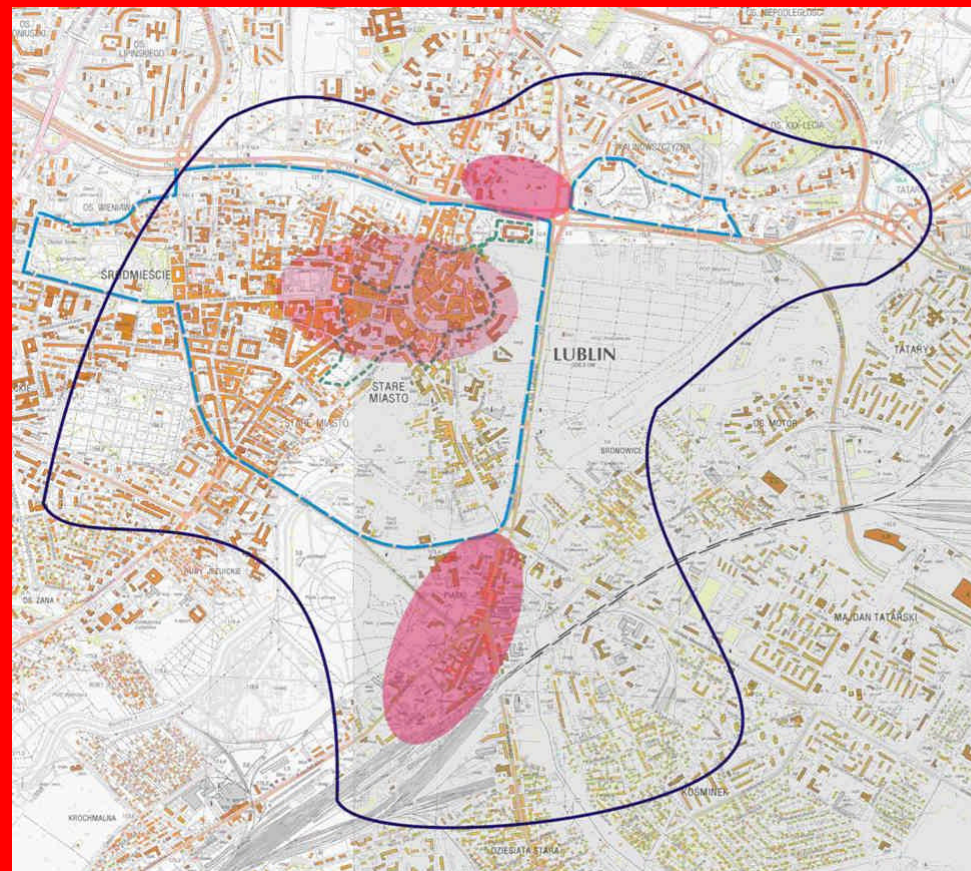

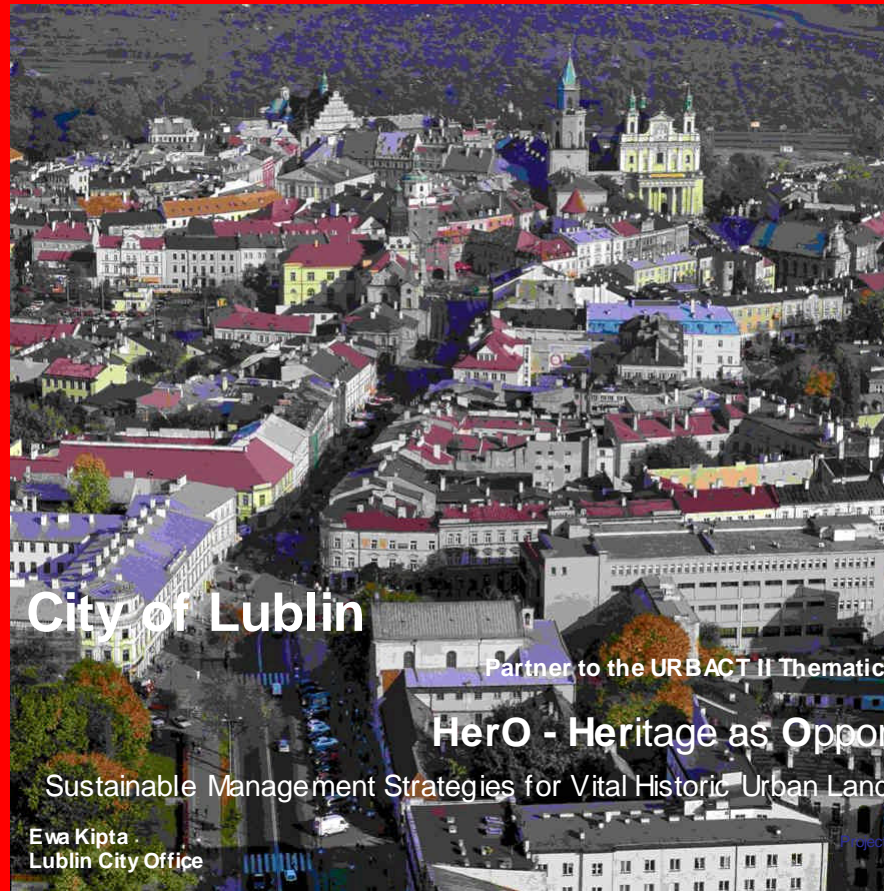

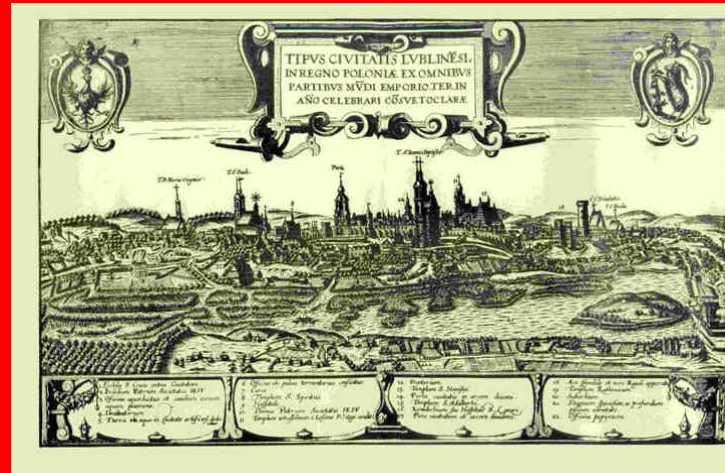

- Lublin has been the site of the Polish-Lithuanian Union in XVI cent.



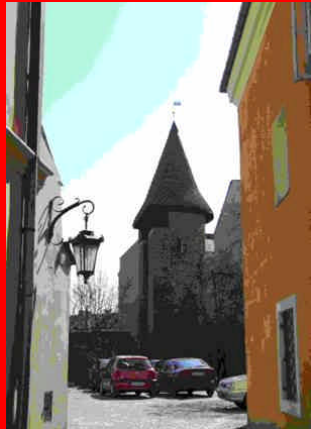
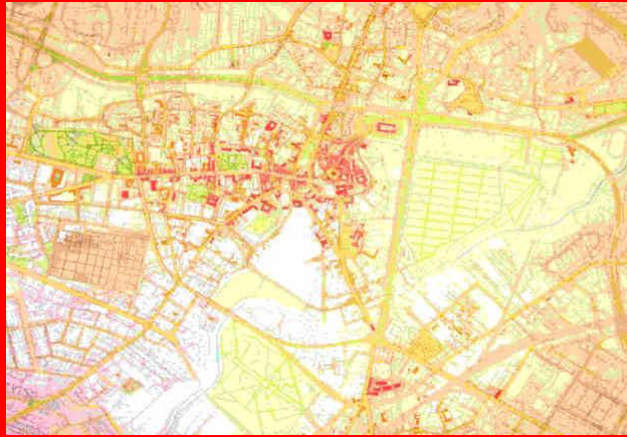

- The local plans for the selected areas of upgrade and change.
- The housing program to upgrade the living standards in the traditional urban texture for the complex quality improvement in the historic urban texture.
- The accessibility of the area of railway station together with replacement the bus station (regional and more distant relations)
- Redevelopment of the area north from the Old Town (Podzamcze)
- Future of the wetlands east from the Old Town (open-air recreation?)
- Assure the sound urban mixture = secure green space and housing in \ the city centre and the areas around.

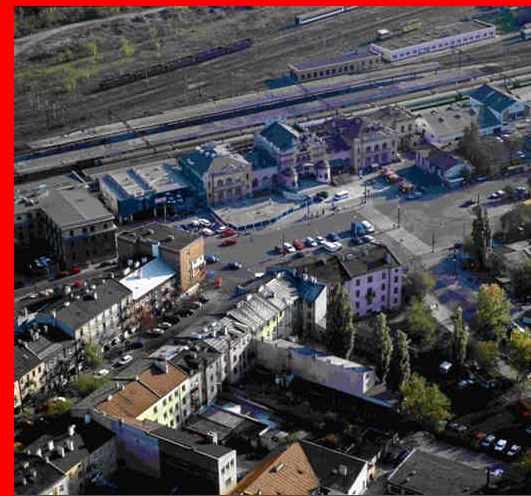

- Sustainable development for growing Euro-regional importance of Lublin with preservation of historic and landscape values

- Formal application to the UNESCO List of World Heritage
- Local plans for the areas of the city centre expansion
- Private-public partnership for the intended development projects
- Efficient support for renovation projects in the concerned area
- Public and green space improvement in the area (together with public safety improvement)
- Economic vitality in the historic urban texture
- Social and cultural integrity for extended city centre
