

Results/Activities

Development and implementation of exchange and learning activities about methods/approaches/ sustainable management strategies for vital historic urban landscapes

Results: a) Increased capacity to balance different demands on historic urban landscapes to facilitate sustainable, urban dev elopment;

b) awareness raising about need for integrated development approach based on cultural heritage. Activities: thematic conferences, workshops, site visits, seminars, trainings, flying experts, case studies/thematic reports

Elaboration of guideline for the development and implementation of integrated cultural heritage management plans

Results: Balanced demands on historic urban landscapes to facilitate the integrated, sustainable urban development

Activities: Guideline for development and implementation of integrated cultural heritage management plans; database of experts, web portal, strategy paper/policy recommendations
