Objective of the CHIMP



The main purposes are:

- start a process of widespread redevelopment of the World Heritage Site through the redefinition of the identity of "culture" and "reception" of the historic Centre as engine of an economic and social development.
- Provide a consensual framework for the conservation and management of the World Heritage Site.
- coordinate the sectoral policies, planning, actions, etc. which are directed or affect historic urban area and their cultural heritage and social value.





Intended Result / Output




- To safeguard the cultural heritage values - material and immaterial - of the area;
- To ensure attraction, competitiveness and multifunctional historic urban areas;
- To improve and preserving smalls activities smalls commercial and crafts activities;
- To attract private investors in a controlled process of social mix development of the area.



1904



 - the social stratification
 - the articulated subdivision of the building heritage

 - Anthropic and environment risk













- What are the differences in the ordinary managerial organization of the entire city and of the area protected by the plan and how are they justified?
- Has it been seen that as a result of the plan in the protected area significant increases of private investment have taken place?
- Do these derive from the realization of specific interventions of requalification?
- Have the motivations been analyzed?
- Has the instituted system of rules induced various guidelines and choices in the behaviour of the other stakeholders. What are they?
- Has control of social changes risk of gentrification phenomena been an element of the plan, with which characteristics?
- Has the plan introduced new norms of building and environmental protection for the area involved?
-) Is it possible to make (or has it been already made) a comparison with other tendentially similar cities, which have not drawn up the management plan on the subject of the protection of the development and of the stakeholder coordination?

The main goal is pursued by restoring the traditional processes of town planning with a special and new enphasis given to social policies.






