








Challenges for Upper Austria due to global crises Export-oriented industry and specialization of the economy regional: Southern Germany, Northern Italy sectoral: automobile sector, pre-production and production of investment goods Decrease in orders Abteilung



Challenges for Upper Austria due to global crises

Focus of the economic stimulus package

- Research and Development
- Favour investments (thermic refurbishment/remediation, public transport, public buildings)
- Assumed liability
- Climate protection measures, modernisation of hospitals
- Qualification
- Flood Protection measures
- Impulses for the tourism and leisure sector
- Keeping people in employment & higher qualification (e.g.: support for companies that cut hours instead of jobs, qualification measures)






Objectives for the next future

- 4 % R&D expenditures of GDP till 2015
- Establishing a new research area in the field of energy efficiency
- International visibility of the research area mechatronics and process automation
- Increasing the number of engineering and natural sciences graduates (Johannes Kepler University Linz)
- Promoting of interest among young people in technical professions (Power Girls, Technikbox)
- Increasing the numbers of students studying abroad
- Further developing the cluster- and network-initiatives as a competence center for cooperation
