- City of Rennes = the capital of Brittany
- The conurbation of Rennes Métropole :
- 37 cities, a population of 402,000
- among the most attractive areas in France : high demographic growth, unemployment rate below national average, over 60,000 students
- stretches out around the city centre, which is separated from the rest of the district by a green belt

<u>Main challenge</u> : maintain its attractiveness for inhabitants and businesses while preserving its unique balance between urban and rural character, its environmental assets and its social cohesion.



A new integrated development programme for the next 20 years in 2006 (a sustainable development strategy within the agenda 21 framework)

- Based on challenges : knowledge society, cohesive society, territorial competition, energy resources
- With respect to the existing founding values : solidarity, quality, identity, innovation and anticipation
- 3 objectives for RM : creative and learning, welcoming and cohesive, attractive and enterprising.




Integrated urban development strategy (2/2)

- A <u>spatial translation</u> : the landplanning policy (SCoT *Territorial coherence scheme*)
- Various <u>sectorial development programmes</u> respect and contribute to this integrated approach : housing, urban mobility, social cohesion, economic development, retail, energy, culture, agriculture, tourism and landuse
- <u>Involvement of actors</u> outside the administration and citizens
- <u>A monitoring tool</u> : a barometer for sustainable development called "Baro'Metropole"



Agenda 21 approach



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- A social cohesion program based on a "social development strategy"
- A partenarial program (national tool "social cohesion urban contract") to define and coordinate partners' actions on specific territories
 - Most actions targeted on deprived neighbourhoods and some aimed at the all territory
 - Coordination of sector-based actions on employment, education and learning, housing, health... Both social and urban approach
 - Involvement of inhabitants
 - The aim pursued is to develop and support specific actions but also to mobilize all common programs and policies
- A monitoring tool to observe social evolutions of the territory and the neighbourhoods



A twofold local action plan :

- Give orientations for an integrated <u>implementation</u> of our current urban development scheme and on the possibilities to improve the <u>involvement</u> of the local stakeholders
- Contribute to the mid-term <u>assessment</u> and rewriting of some of our main planning and evaluation tools



- define and test a framework on integrated urban development (both on planning and on implementation)
- exchange experiences and good practices in the field of integrated urban development plans and implementation
- exchange experiences and good practices on governance and partnership, be it on a local level or on a regional or metropolitan level
- benefit from training and empowerment actions for the local stakeholders
