



Municipality as the Intermediate










Municipality as the Intermediate










JESSICA Project Workflow





Essential Competences



Municipality Project idea Local or regional contact points "Could this be a project for our UDF?" Local approval 1. Urban development goals 2. Economic feasibility

Competences

Qualification in regard of public interests on *urban development questions*:

- Does the project fit into the urban development plan?
- Is the applicant (willing to get) involved in local cooperation structures?
- Is the applicant aware of the urban development goals reached with the project?
- Is the applicant experienced with urban development projects?
- Is there a need for public intervention?

Essential Competences



Municipality Project idea Local or regional contact points "Could this be a project for our UDF?" Local approval 1. Urban development goals 2. Economic feasibility Start the project

Competences

Qualification in regard of *economic feasibility* to repay funds:

- Is the applicant trustworthy?
- What is the whole capital expenditure?
- What kind of revenues are expected? How much?
- What are the risks connected to the revenues?
- What kind of dependencies will occur?
- What happens if the project fails? Is there a material value as security?
- Are there alternative ways of financing the project? Why JESSICA?

Possible ways of filling the lack of competence:

- Learning by doing
- Searching professionals in the own administration
- Recruitment of professional employees for the own administration / UDF
- Secondment of professionals for the own administration / UDF
- Commissioning of external experts
- → Training to get the needed competences for handling fund financed projects?
