






Aachens LSG

Aachen as part of tri-national region Euregio Meuse-Rhine


- approx 3,9 Mio. inhabitants 48 % in B, 33 % in DE, 19% in NL

- International region with three languages & five cultures
- GDP: 86,5 bill. Euro (2005)
- Five major universities with more than 68.000 students, 1.200 professors & leading research institutes






