Innovation as a Driver for Job Creation

The Integrated Action Plan of Plasencia (IAP) is a strategic document in which the of local development employment are identified. The city's problems and opportunities are analyzed sustainable and short-term and middle-term solutions are included. This document becomes a specific and useful tool for the city, based on the resources and domains of smart specialization. In this way, the companies will have instruments to increase their dynamism, talent attraction and retain human capital. The final goal is to solve enterprises' problems competitiveness level and create new jobs.

This Action Plan is the result of a participative process, made with consensus by the participants. The action

plan includes a timetable and budget to be developed. The stakeholders that participate in the design of the plan are enterprises, social organizations, universities, research centres and the technical office of the Extremadura Smart Specialization Strategy RIS3 at the Regional level.

Plasencia is participating with 9 other European cities in the URBACT – IN FOCUS project. This group of cities has worked together as a network to learn and develop actions to improve business competitiveness, and allow the creation of sustainable and quality employment. This process aims to make Plasencia an attractive city to investors and become a reference of the smart specialization at a local level.

Starting point

Plasencia is a reference in terms of local economic development based on its historic and artistic heritage, and part of this knowhow can be capitalized on in terms of smart specialization. The city also has an extensive experience in transborder cooperation.

The city's environmental benefits make it unique as an urban center with lot of gardens, parks, natural paths and protected natural spaces. The measures impulse at the environmental area will improve the image of the city and the external position of their products and services.



There are a few factors that position Plasencia as a referential urban core in terms of education, health, wellbeing and quality of life, thanks to health services, university education offers and the natural environment of the area.

The priorities of the city at technological, industrial and sector levels are aligned with the reginal RIS3, whose focal sectors are agro-food, clean energy, tourism, health and ICTs.

URBACT as a framework for reflection and learning

URBACT- IN FOCUS has provided the proper context to strengthen citizen participation, even if this process was well articulated during several years. The participation process is being enriched in terms of productive field, something that was demanded by the employers.

International exchanges have been formed towards different thematic workshops: connecting the RIS3 to the

city; local economic development based on clusters related to RIS3; improving the local entrepreneurship scene; maximizing environmental approach; areas for smart specialization and urban internationalization. Members of the URBACT local group have worked in some of these workshops, transferring their knowledge to the rest of the city's operators.



The role of Plasencia in the strategy of smart specialization at local level

Various partners of the project have analyzed the concept of "smart specialization at the local level". This enables Plasencia to design and develop, together with the technical office of RIS3 at the Regional level, new projects and

services to support the enterprises competitiveness from the innovation. It aims to achieve sustainable development and a better capacity to create jobs in the city.

Environment

Especially the Forestry Sector, as there are several local enterprises that develop this type of work. The University of Extremadura offers degree in Forestry Environmental engineering in Plasencia. The Research Centre of Ecological and Mountain Agriculture (CAEM) is also set in Plasencia. There is an important annual called Feria Forestal event IBER-FORESTA, the Iberian Event for forestry professionals and investigators, whose goal is to become the most for important forestry event the Mediterranean ecosystem. The circular economy development is increasing and exploring new fields job entrepreneurial options to take advantage of forestry waste (high in the North of Extremadura).

Tourism

Plasencia contributes to this sector thanks to the important heritage management developed by the city, as well as its valued natural heritage (Jerte River and its sports potential, the protected Natural Park Monte de Valcorchero, the Vía de la Plata -the ancient commercial path that crosses the region-, the National Park of Monfragüe, close to the town, and other areas in the North of the Region).

Health

Especially the attention to elderly and dependent people. A new elderly center is going to be built thanks to European Funds (European Regional Development Fund, ERDF). The degrees in Nursing and Podiatry offered by the University of Extremadura in Plasencia, together with the professionals of the ITCs sector, will have the necessary tools to research and innovate in this field. The previously mentioned elderly center will become a Living Lab of new solutions regarding the "senior's economy". In relation with this, a private project will work to use technology in order to improve the elder's quality of life.







Work Line 1: Revitalization of the Commercial and Tourism Sector




